Dear competitors,

In one month, we'll welcome you to the J/70 world Corinthian championships in Marseille. For helping you to prepare this event, you could find in this document a lot of information.

1- Venue & Logistics aspects

a. Venue & parking

Event Address

The marina is a restricted access area. It's not an open public area.

So, you should wear the event wristband to entry. This wristband will be distributed to you at registration desk when you arrive. No car is allowed inside the marina except for the first and last day.





2 Upon arrival with your vehicle and trailer, entry to the marina is by appointment only (based on your equipment inspection schedule). Please stop at the gate for the first check. Drive along the buildings, then enter the marina after the second building for the second check.

8 **Pedestrian Access to the Site**
Pedestrian access is via the building to the right of the main entrance. Please check in at the reception to have your name verified on the event list. An accreditation wristband will be issued at registration to allow entry throughout the championship.

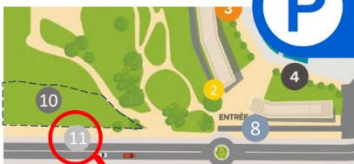


P Parking

11 **Vehicle access is prohibited in the marina during the championship.** Please use the P1 "Palm Beach" parking lot (Fee (€5.20 per 24 hours), payable by participants, vehicles without trailers) or the authorized parking spaces near the site. The parking area is not monitored. The organizer is not responsible for improper parking by participants or for parking fees.

11 **Vehicle access is prohibited in the marina during the championship.** Please use the P1 "Palm Beach" parking area (vehicles without trailers) or the authorized parking spaces near the site. The parking area is not monitored. The organizer is not responsible for improper parking by participants or for parking fees.



Parking area not reserved for the regatta.
Fee (€5.20 per 24 hours), payable by participants.

The height restriction barrier at the entrance may be lifted by the organizer upon request to the Race Office, allowing access for high vehicles (under discussion with the City of Marseille authorities)



Overnight stays (camping) in the parking area are strictly prohibited.



As the parking area is not monitored 24/7, participants are advised not to leave any valuables visible inside their vehicles in order to reduce the risk of break-ins.



b. [Book an inspection slot](#)



Before coming to the event, **you will book an inspection slot** on the event website (available from the 20 of April 14:00 CET). Entrance in the marina is allowed only 3 hours before inspection slot.

c. [Book a Vakaros Atlas 2 rental](#) (for those who don't own one)

This event needs a Vakaros Atlas 2. If you don't own one, you could rent it with its mount for the event. It'll be delivered during the registration.

You will need to select 2026 J/70 Corinthian Worlds. Rentals **are due 14 days before checking**.

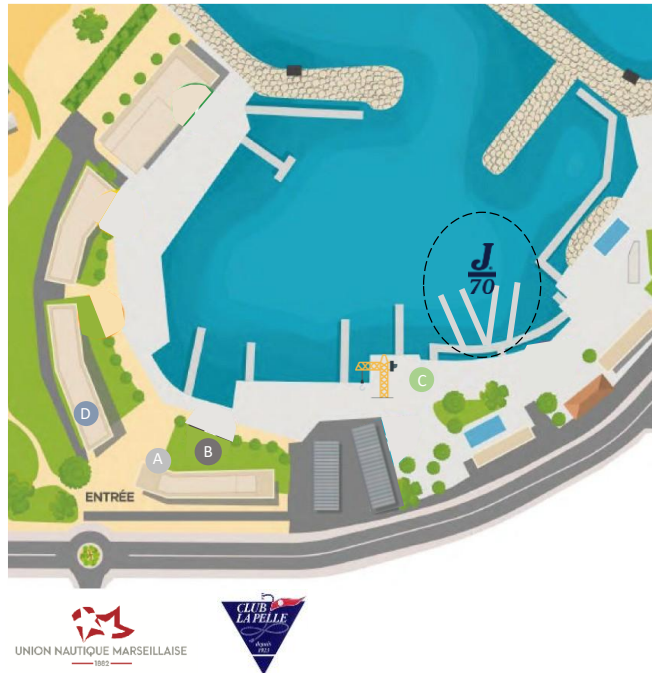
d. Vakaros & registration

3- During the event

a. The village

Inside the marina, you could find a village with large screen and a resting area.

b. Schedule

The official board defines the schedule. The first warning signal is at 13h and could be updated regarding the weather conditions.

c. After Race

Each day after racing you could debrief your races in front of the large screen with the daily photos or videos. Some food trucks will be there also.

The marina will close at 22h each day.

d. Accompanying persons

To entry into the marina an event wristband is mandatory for each accompanying person. You could buy additional wristband on our website (in your registration page). This wristband band includes participation for after races each day, opening ceremony and closure party.

e. Sandwiches & salad pack

Each team could preorder sandwiches packs or salad packs for the 5 races.

These packs include a sandwich or salad, a dessert and a drink.

The price for sandwiches is 60 € per person for 5 days and 65€ for salads

packs. Each day a new recipe!! You could preorder till 7 days before the regatta on your registration form. And on the desk later.

f. [SPV Coachs book a fee](#)

Coaches and Ribs need to be declared to the organizing authority.

A fee is to be paid on your registration form. Support Person Vessels: €100

This fee includes on-site boat reception and access to the venue and social events for the coach.

g. [Haul-out at the end :](#)

Haul-out will be organized on Sunday.

A haul-out will be defined based on the distance to do for going home.

No craning will be done on Saturday.

b. [Camper van](#)

Q: We are driving down Campervan. We are staying in an apartment during the event but am hoping to find somewhere safe to park the van - we would not be using or staying in the van.

A: You could park your camper Van in the parking P1 “Palm Beach” during the event. We couldn’t guarantee safety, as this park isn’t guarded.

We recommend storing your camper van at Marly PARC: <https://www.marly-parc.fr/>, not so far from the marina. Or store it in Indigo Park at Le MUCEUM J4 [INDIGO - MUCEM](#) (till 3,2m height).

d. Crane on Saturday at the end of the event
